- 5. Enclose proof of manufacturing licenses, and certified kitchens with temporary food permit application. If using a certified kitchen other than your own, you must provide an authorizing letter from such kitchen.
- 6. Vendors shall provide copies of all applicable licenses, permits and liability insurance certificates.
- Any vendor selling a consumable food product MUST complete and return to the Chamber of Commerce a Temporary Food Permit Application for the City of Sugar Land. This permit application is on the market website. The market covers any permit costs and provides the hand and ware washing stations for the market.
